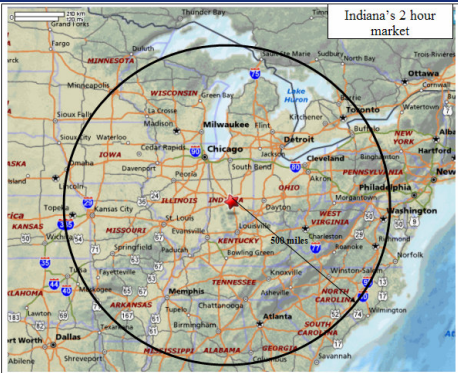


On-Demand Transportation
